St. John Ambulance Emergency First Aid Course

The squadron has arranged a one day First Aid training session to be given by St. John Ambulance staff on Saturday May 12, 2012, from 0900 – 1630 with a half hour for lunch, (bring your own) at their facilities at 250 Gage Ave in Kitchener. A refrigerator and microwave are available. Parking is free on site. The cost is \$79.00 (squadron discount) per person with a maximum of 20 in the class to be signed up on a first come first served basis. To enroll please complete the application form included on page 4 in this issue and forward it to **Glenn Shugg, 59 Parkview Cr, Kitchener, ON, N2A 1M1** by April 30, 2012 together with a cheque payable to **Kitchener-Waterloo Power & Sail Squadron**. Should the course be over enrolled your cheque will be held until we can determine a future course date keeping in mind a minimum of 10 persons are required. If another course cannot be arranged your cheque will be returned.

The course leads to a certificate and includes: Roles and Responsibilities of the First Aider; casualty management – unresponsive and conscious with head/spinal injuries, adult resuscitation including CPR/Defibrillation, severe bleeding, medical conditions including diabetes, asthma, allergies & seizures, wound care and burns

Clean Conscience

Spring into spring with a clean conscience. As you prepare for spring commissioning this season, consider replacing harsh chemicals and commercial cleaners with less corrosive alternative cleaning products. Not only will this be more environmentally responsible but you'll also save considerable money as well. Encourage fellow boaters at your marina to do the same. Here are some recipes for inexpensive yet effective cleaning products.

- *fibreglass stains* - make a paste of baking soda and water. Use a sponge or soft cloth and gently rub the mix into the stain. This paste can also be used to clean onboard showers and heads. While baking soda is an excellent all-around cleaner, keep in mind that it is abrasive, so use with care. Use lemon or lime juice as a final wipe-down for a shiny, fresh-smelling finish.
- *windows and mirrors* - mix vinegar, lemon juice and warm water. Fill a spray bottle with the solution. Spray it on your windows and wipe with paper towels or newspapers.
